2015 Application Process

- Completed USC Graduate Application
- A Bachelor's degree and minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0; official transcripts from each accredited college or university attended
 - Note: USC alumni and current students are not required to submit USC transcripts.
- All applicants must submit Graduate Record Examination (GRE) scores.
 - Note: Records of GRE scores are purged after 5 years. Please visit ETS online (<https://www.ets.org/>) for GRE exam information.
 - Applicants may substitute MCAT scores less than 5 years old for GRE scores.
- A minimum of three (3) letters of recommendation
- A Statement of Purpose of approximately 2-3 pages addressing the following questions:
 - Why are you interested in pursuing the NIIN degree?
 - How will a NIIN degree affect or enhance your career aspirations and goals?
- A Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Resume
- All international applicants must submit TOEFL/IELTS scores.
 - Note: Records of TOEFL/IELTS scores are purged after two years. Please visit the Educational Testing Service online (<https://www.ets.org/toefl>) for TOEFL exam information.
